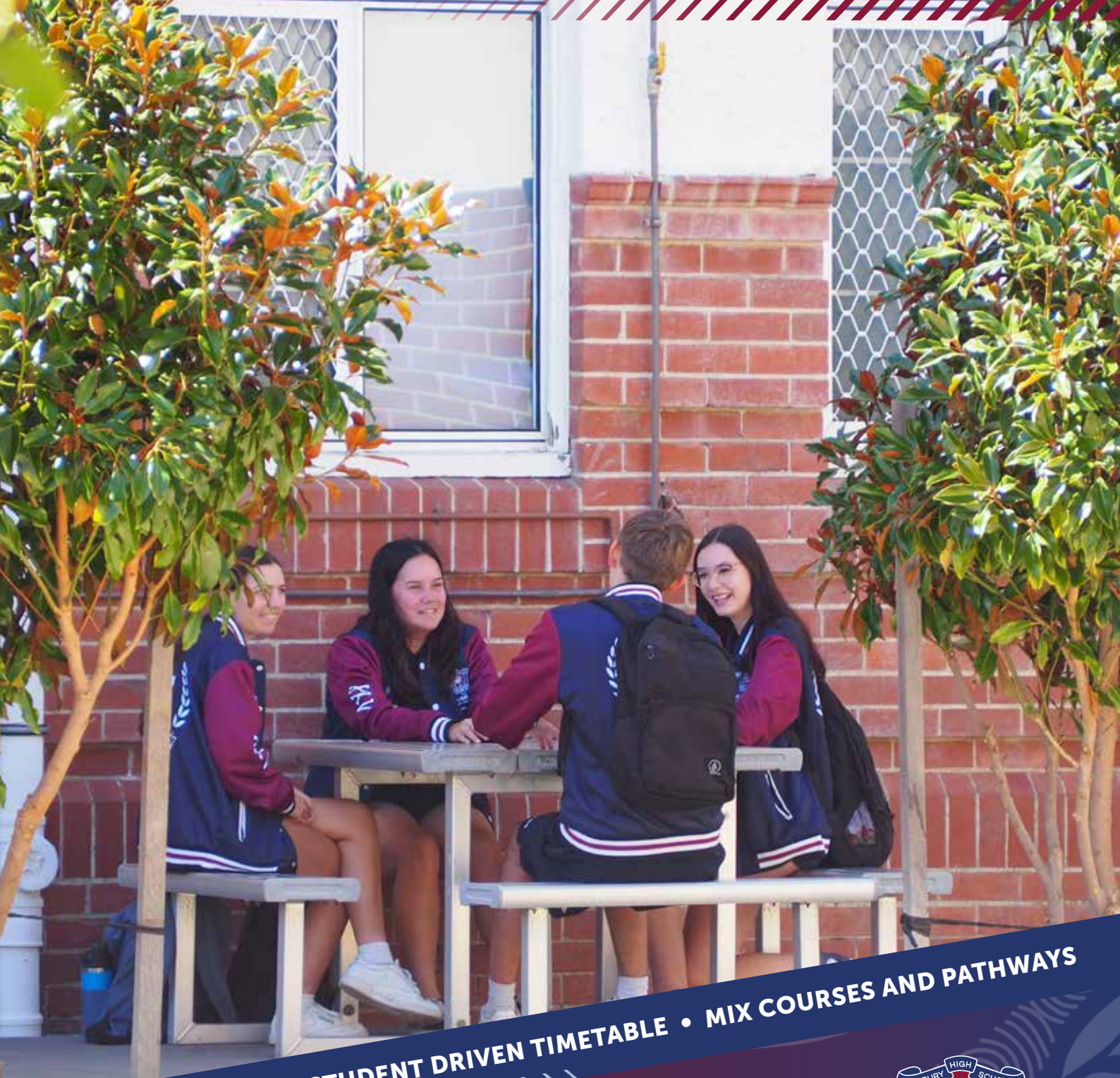

- Minimum B grades in English/Mathematics/Science/HASS are a requirement for competitive certificate applications
- Certificate IV applications are available to Year 12 students only.
- A successful offer for enrolment is significantly influenced by:
  - Behavioural data (school reports and school reference)
  - Regular attendance
