



E-bikes and e-rideables

The safety of students is our priority and under WA laws, only individuals aged 16 and over are permitted to use e-rideables or e-bikes with the motor engaged.

Students in **Years 7, 8, 9 or 10**, regardless of age, are not permitted **to ride or store** e-bikes or e-rideables to Bunbury Senior High School.

If a student in Years 7, 8, 9 or 10 brings an e-rideable or e-bike onto school grounds, parents/carers will be contacted to collect the device.

e-rideables

Students in Years 11 and 12 may apply for a permit, through the Manager of Senior School, to ride and store their e-rideable (refer to additional policy).

Students in Years 11 and 12 may store their e-rideable at the bike racks near the

Demountable/room 25 at their own risk, provided they comply with all relevant laws, including:

- Helmets are required
- Only one rider at a time
- Maximum speed: 10 km/h on footpaths.

e-bikes

Students in Years 11 and 12 may apply for a permit, through the Manager of Senior School, to ride and store their e-bike (refer to additional policy).

Students in Years 11 and 12 may store their e-bike at the bike racks near the

demountable at their own risk, provided they comply with all relevant laws, including:

- The motor can have a maximum power output up to 250 watts
- The bike needs human power to make it move - it is not meant to be ridden using the
- motor alone
- The road rules applying to regular bicycle riders also apply to eBike riders.

Please be aware that not all eRideables or eBikes sold in WA are legal to ride on WA roads and paths. Visit the Road Safety Commission for more information on [eRideable](#) and [eBike](#) laws, penalties, buying guides and safety.
